In response to your letter of June 16, 1972, we propose to utilize the grant in the following fashion:

I. English Department - We will stress these areas this year:

- a. Women in Literature and Life
- b. Shaping of the Modern Mind
- c. Communications Workshops
- d. Issues in Comparative Literature

Total Budget, 6 Teachers \$ 58,000.00

II. Mathematics Department - This year we will interrelate skills and knowledges developed by students in mathematics with all areas of humanities. This, of course, would include use of statistics in developing experimental designs directed toward community explorations.

Total Budget, 5 Teachers \$ 37,000.00

III. Social Studies Department - The focus this year will be upon the individual in the urban setting. We will highlight such courses as The Individual in the Urban Setting, and Urban Planning. Through these two broad areas, we will interrelate principles of architecture, budget planning, demographic studies, urban sociology, cultural anthropology, and municipal law.

Total Budget - 4 Teachers \$ 33,500.00
